### *How do I apply for Federal & State Financial Aid?*

1. Complete the **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). FAFSA's are available on the Internet at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). The FAFSA should be submitted as soon as possible after January 1. Check with your school(s) for deadlines
2. In 3-5 weeks after submitting the FAFSA, you should receive a Student Aid Report (SAR). Review the information on the SAR to make sure the information is correct. If you have not received a SAR after 6 weeks, contact the Federal Student Aid Information Center at (319)337-5665 or 800-433-3243.
3. Check with your college for other forms that might be required to complete their financial aid application process.
4. In March or April watch for a financial aid letter award notification from the financial aid office. This will indicate the types of aid you will be eligible to receive.

### *Who is Eligible for Financial Aid?*

To be eligible you must:

- Have financial need\*
  - Have a high school diploma, GED or pass an independently administered test approved by the U.S. Dept. of Education
  - Be enrolled in an eligible program of higher education
  - Be a U.S. Citizen or eligible non-citizen
  - If a male and 18 or older, register with the Selective Service
  - Complete forms as required by the federal government and college(s) you've selected
  - Make satisfactory academic progress
- \* How Is Financial Need Determined?

Financial need is the Cost of Attendance (COA) at the school minus the Expected Family Contribution (EFC).

**Cost of Attendance** includes the tuition & fees, room & board, books & supplies transportation and miscellaneous & personal expenses while attending college.

**Expected Family Contribution** is determined by a federal need analysis formula based on the Information reported on the FAFSA.

## ALL SPORTS PASS

All sports passes are now on sale. The passes will admit the holder to all regular high school and junior high contests. The passes are not valid for tournaments. The costs are as follows:

Theatre seats per event (Senior Citizens)	\$ 3.00
Reserved theatre seats (includes gate for both varsity boys and girls basketball)	\$140.00
Panther punch pass (10 events, JH & HS)	\$ 45.00

\*Theatre seat selection is made at the time of pass purchase. Passes will be numbered according to seat selection(s). Pass holder is responsible to notify any individual occupying seat by presenting pass.

Any pass that is lost, stolen or misplaced, will be replaced at a cost of \$7.00. All passes must be presented at the gate, in the event no pass is presented, current gate price will be in effect. NO EXCEPTIONS! No sharing passes is allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS



## CHILDREN'S' BEHAVIOR AT SPORTING EVENTS

It has come to our attention that a number of children are unsupervised while attending sporting events at Stryker Schools. Everyone is welcome to come and enjoy the action at Panther events.
